ⁱ Several sources were consulted to compile the goaltender data in this book. Sources include Sebastien Tremblay's *Goaltenders: The Expansion Years, 1967-1979*, p. 158-401, "The Hockey Summary Project" at <http://www.flyershistory.com/cgi-bin/hspgames.cgi>, the *Oakland Tribune*, *San Mateo Times*, *Hayward Daily Review*, and *Winnipeg Free Press*. , among others, the statistics I have put together for goaltenders should be quite accurate, but should not be seen as definitive by any means. For the years 1979-1988, I consulted Jeff Z. Klein and Karl-Eric Reif's *The Hockey Compendium*, 2001 edition, p. 96-122. The statistics for many seasons between 1954 and 1976 were painstakingly compiled by Edward Yuen of Regina, Saskatchewan, and included in *The Hockey Compendium*. According to Klein and Reif, empty-net goals were not considered in the final shots and goals records, something Sebastien Tremblay also took into consideration. Since the NHL counted empty-net shots and goals against the goaltender who was pulled, official statistics and those in the sources I consulted may not always match. The statistics in this section are by no means official and are subject to variations depending on the newspaper consulted, therefore I have decided to round save percentages to the nearest thousandth. At the very least, this section should give you a fairly accurate career summary of every goaltender to ever play for the Seals or Barons. As for the statistics for goalies who played in the WHA, the websites www.hockeydb.com and www.hockey-reference.com were invaluable sources. It should also be noted that all career statistics are exactly as NHL sources claim them to be, even though some differences were found when I cross-checked goaltenders' game-by-game statistics with the Seals and Barons. I did not take these differences into account when including career statistics since there are probably other errors the league has never corrected, and that I was unable to confirm. My primary concern was statistics directly related to the Seals/Barons franchise, therefore, I did not bother to check the statistics for every game of every goaltender's career.
